A rundown of the Scenarios x3 for the plan to evolve from

There is a lot of focused detail in the largest document aimed at specific areas like Heritage, Environment, Transport etc under the heading of Improvements in the Public Realm

Hazen – Disappointed with how heavy the documents are without a real pinpoint focus on somethings/suggestions written in plain English speak. To much council "jargon" Rachel—Issue with transport development around the expanding schools with close proximity of Bus routes along small streets.

Rhonda—Dangers around the Caladonian School access with no school crossing in Humffray St.

Lisa responded—Currently a Future Transport Master Plan being worked on by council and Vic Roads to give safer connections and flow. Feedback thru the LAP questionnaire will add to the discussions.

Action—BHPA will work thru the LAP questionnaire as a group. If all interested parties could please read the LAP Summary and Questions over the next week or so we will call a meeting in perhaps 2 weeks to formulate responses.

Responses need to be in by March 8<sup>th</sup>.

The LAP has been promoted via council website, mentioned on radio by the Mayor and thru distribution via BHPA contacts thanks Sarah.

Next Stage --? A discussion evening before the March 8<sup>th</sup> cut off

Then work on a draft plan to be followed by a Community Consult day at the hall perhaps in April.
