Categories

1. A4 drawing - **Pre-School**
2. A4 drawing - **Junior Primary Students**: Prep to Grade Two
3. A4 drawing - **Senior Primary Students**: Grade Three to Grade Six
4. Photograph (5 x 7 inches) - **Secondary Students**
5. Photograph (5 x 7 inches) - **Adult** (over 18 years old)

How to Enter

1. Depending on which category you are entering, draw a picture or pictures or take some photos of something or someone in Brown Hill, trying to capture what you feel is the essence of our great suburb.
2. Photographers, select your favourite photo/s and print one hard copy (5x7 inches) in colour or black and white.
4. Collect and complete the entry form (available from the Brown Hill Community Online Hub (brownhill.vic.au/brown-hill-community-festival/) or in hard copy from Brown Hill Kindergarten or Caledonian Primary School).
5. Submit your image/s at Brown Hill Kindergarten (1 Reid Court) or Caledonian Primary School (Thompson Street) during office hours: 8.30am - 4.00pm weekdays during school term. Please note, school holidays are from Saturday 23 September until Sunday 8 October 2017, during which time the kindergarten and the school will be closed.

All entries are due by 12.00 noon on Friday 20 October 2017.

6. Each image requires a separate entry form. One person may submit up to three (3) images.

Prizes

Winners will receive great prizes donated by local community groups and businesses, including book vouchers or day passes to the Brown Hill Swimming Pool for the 2017-2018 season.

Entries will be displayed at the Brown Hill Community Festival and may also be displayed at Caledonian Primary School, the Brown Hill Hotel, the Central Highlands Library (Doveton Street, Ballarat) and various other locations. With permission, images may be published in the Brown Hill Community Newsletter and on the Brown Hill community Facebook pages ('Making Brown Hill' and 'Brown Hill Community Festival') and the Community Online Hub (brownhill.vic.au).
